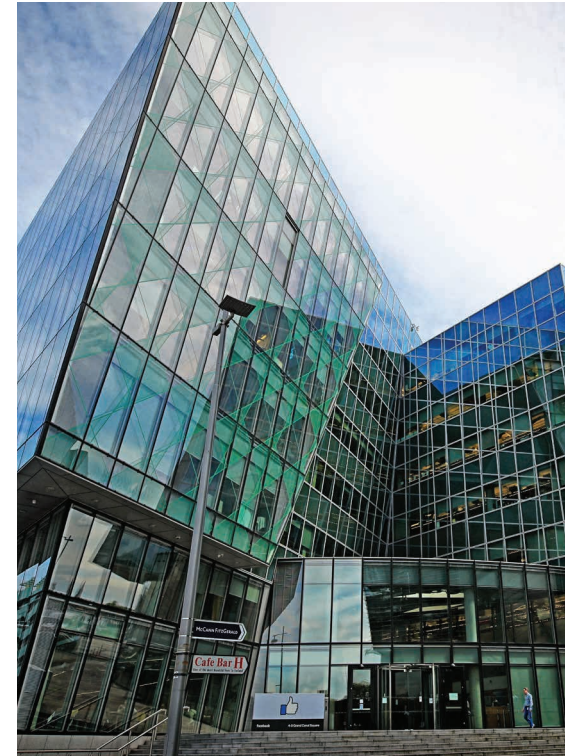

Less than two and a half miles from the centre of Dublin, our campus is very secure, with 24-hour Reception and 24-hour Security. We are located in a quiet and affluent suburban area that is safe to explore at any time.



From the end of May through August each year, UCD plays host to a large number of interns and Study Abroad students from the USA and Europe, so it's very easy to socialise and settle in with like-minded people.

Getting here is super easy.

The UCD campus at Belfield is just 2.5 miles from the centre of Dublin. The second largest bus terminus in Ireland is located here, so frequent buses can whisk interns into their workplace in the heart of Dublin in less than fifteen minutes on a dedicated Bus Corridor.

The AirCoach from Dublin Airport also stops on our college grounds, so getting here in the first place is convenient. And if working outside the city centre, interns can easily commute directly from UCD to high-density employment areas such as Sandyford and Bray.



Dublin is also awash with cultural and tourist riches, and many of the museums, galleries and other attractions are free of charge, so a summer internship in Dublin is not just work, work, work! And with a friendly and open disposition, the Irish really love to welcome strangers to their city and to their country.



At weekends, just a two or three-hour flight can see interns exploring Paris, Rome, Barcelona, Vienna, London, Prague, Budapest or Florence, making the broad educational experience even richer.

All our beautifully appointed apartments are self-catering, with weekly cleaning and change of bed linen. Interns have the luxury of their own private bedroom, and share the living room and kitchen with other interns.



All our guests have the option of being self-sufficient, although there are extensive catering facilities on campus and close-by. There's also a state-of-the-art self-service launderette on-site.



A free social and cultural programme lets our guests mingle with other interns and students in a supportive and educational environment. This includes everything from visits to the Cliffs of Moher, traditional afternoon teas, Irish dancing, hurling lessons, free movie nights in our cinema and, most importantly, pet therapy!



There's also very fast WIFI available, at no cost to interns, so it's easy to stay in contact with home. And in case of emergency, a Student Medical Centre is available on-campus, while the world-class St. Vincent's University Hospital is very close to the college.
