Academic Program Offerings

With over fifty years' experience in international education, AIFS offers study abroad programs of the highest academic quality, with a commitment to the health and safety of your students. With academic year, semester, summer and inter-term programs in more than 20 countries, your students will have an increased diversity of programs to consider. By affiliating, your institution will add to its academic offerings the curriculum at more than 30 institutions of higher education around the world, without any investment of time or money and with no additional commitment of present or future resources.

AIFS Study Abroad has developed relationships with outstanding universities in each of our program locations, and works with these institutions that share our commitment to academic excellence. We continually evaluate our program offerings and assess student outcomes.

Financial Benefits – Students receive a monetary grant in the amount of \$400 per semester or \$200 for summer/January Term programs. At the discretion of the institution, these funds may be applied directly to your student AIFS invoices, or paid to your institution for the administration of grants/scholarships or for other program support services. There are no minimum enrollment requirements under the AIFS Affiliation Agreement.

Special Billing Arrangements – AIFS arranges for the invoicing of your students and/or your institution, designed to specifications you request. This serves to maintain your students' enrollment status on your campus and facilitates the use of applicable financial aid, scholarships and grants and loans (note: affiliation is not required to request special billing arrangements).

Advisor Portal – AIFS provides Affiliates with access to a special portal on our website enabling them to view information on their students' enrollment status in our programs.

Customized Faculty-Led Programs – AIFS works with both its affiliated and non-affiliated partners to provide support for customized, faculty-led study abroad programs. As institutions seek to broaden options and create development opportunities for faculty, AIFS offers a broad range of services in a diversity of countries.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Program Site Visits – Broaden your staff and faculty members' knowledge of the world through visits to our program sites. Education abroad professionals know that having good on-site knowledge of programs is to key to successful student advising. AIFS arranges site visits to select program sites each semester. Staff and faculty from all AIFS Affiliates are eligible to request to participate; AIFS covers most costs including airfare, hotel, ground transportation and most meals. The capacity for participation on funded site visits varies each year and requests are accommodated based on available spaces. Site visit participants are asked to provide a written report to be shared with other sending institutions.

Board of Advisors – The AIFS Study Abroad Board of Academic Advisors is made up of international education professionals who typically represent colleges and universities with missions supporting the advancement of education abroad as a component of internationalization.

AIFS invites individuals to serve on the Board as volunteers, seeking their advice and counsel on issues related to study abroad program development, management and evaluation. The Board meets annually and communicates with its members throughout the year to discuss issues as they arise.

Workshops and Seminars – International education professionals and faculty from Affiliated institutions are given priority invitation to the occasional workshops and seminars sponsored by AIFS.

HOW DO INSTITUTIONS WORK WITH AIFS?

AIFS seeks to make its programs available to your students to consider among the range of choices they have, including your institutionally run programs, exchanges and those provided by other organizations. Typically, Affiliates make AIFS catalogs available to interested students, permit and facilitate the use of applicable financial aid, facilitate the transfer of credit, invite AIFS to study abroad fairs, create links to the AIFS website, display posters in prominent locations, advise AIFS on potential program offerings, arrange student meetings and are generally knowledgeable about AIFS study abroad programs.

This Af	ffiliation Agreement begins with the semester and continues indefinitely until either party decides to discontinue it.		
Affilia	ation Agreement Purpose		
1.			
2.	To enable students to consider AIFS study abroad programs among their options.		
3.	To provide financial and advising support for students studying abroad.		
Respo	onsibilities of AIFS Study Abroad		
1.			
2.	AIFS will organize site visits each semester to select program destinations, providing for the costs for air transportation, hotel and meals for a representative from its Affiliate partners. AIFS will accept requests for participation in these scheduled site visits, and will work to accommodate as many requests as possible. If capacity limits prevent an institution from participating, priority will be given to that institution for future site visits. Institutions may elect to participate in site visits at their own cost.		
3.	AIFS agrees to accept all Affiliate Institution applicants provided they meet stated admission criteria, which will enable the Study Abroad Office to inform students of the likelihood of acceptance. It should be noted that an accepted student does not have a confirmed space until the required deposit is paid. Application deadlines are listed in the AIFS Study Abroad catalogs.		
4.	AIFS will accept applications individually from students, or they may be channeled through the Study Abroad Office and submitted to AIFS as a group at the discretion of the Affiliate Institution.		
5.	AIFS will facilitate the issuance of academic transcripts from its host university partners abroad, which be sent at the conclusion of each semester to a designated recipient students' home institutions.		
6.	AIFS agrees to cooperate with the Affiliate Institution on alternate invoicing procedures, if requested. Students are typically billed directly by AIFS. However, arrangements can be made with the Affiliate Institution to directly bill the institution for some or all of the students' charges. (Please request a Special Billing Request form for any new or updated arrangements.)		
7.	AIFS will supply copies of student evaluation summaries if requested.		
8.	AIFS will list the Affiliate Institution as an Additional Insured on the AIFS liability policies should it be so desired.		
Respo	onsibilities of the Affiliated Institution		
1.	To work with its own Registrar's Office, or appropriate transfer of credit office, to facilitate the transfer of credit from AIFS programs.		
2.	To work with its own Financial Aid Office to facilitate the use of applicable financial aid and loans by its students who are eligible for such aid and who wish to study abroad on AIFS programs.		
3.	To maintain a supply of AIFS catalogs to make available to prospective students.		
4.	To include approved AIFS study abroad programs on its program directory.		
5.	To provide a link to the AIFS Abroad website from its study abroad website or portal.		
6.	To include AIFS in printed and electronic materials promoting affiliated programs of study abroad.		
7.	To display AIFS posters in the Study Abroad Office and/or at other campus locations where permitted.		
8.	To provide assistance for visiting AIFS staff to meet with prospective students. Additionally, the Affiliate Institution agrees to foster study abroad in general, as well as providir information about AIFS programs in particular.		
9.	To promote study abroad in general on its campus by means of posters and advertising. AIFS will provide materials, if requested.		
10.	To organize study abroad fair(s) and/or student information sessions at which AIFS and other study abroad organizations may attend and promote it's programs.
