Our 2017 trauma registry

determined that 61% of pediatric burn admits were scald burns and most were < 6 years old.

Geo-mapping identified at risk areas by ethnicity and zip-codes. Our Burn Awareness Week messaging was designed based on this information.

More than 1500 people attended the 5-day event.


