PARIS, FRANCE

- *How can a restaurant become zero-waste?*
- *How would a jobs project for immigrants and refugees be sustainable and make money?*
- *What do bikes and education in Africa have in common?*

This activity seeks to change student perspectives and inspire their next big change-making idea.

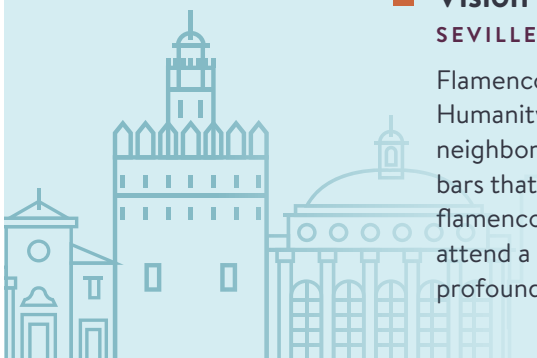


■ Public Lecture Series

SEVILLE, SPAIN

Flamenco, a UNESCO-declared "Masterpiece of Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity," is an emblematic symbol of Spanish culture and art. Seville's Triana neighborhood, a.k.a. the birthplace of flamenco, is home to dozens of small bars that host live performances. In an interactive workshop, students will learn flamenco's legacy and receive basic musical and dance instruction. They will also attend a professional flamenco show and will soak in the powerful emotions, from profound sorrow to great joy.
