

Why should students study abroad?

- Less than 10% of US college students study abroad
- Shows college admissions and employers skills such as intercultural competence, initiative, understanding of diversity, problem solving, "thinking out of the box"...
- Personal skills you gain: independence, creativity, tolerance, openness, a sense of humor, adaptability, flexibility, values, patience...









Customized Faculty Led Programs:

- **Customized** A collaborative process to create a program you would like to run.
- **Cost-efficient** Your institution retains tuition fees and students pay a program fee to AIFS. Student financial aid still applies, making study abroad an affordable option for more students.
- **Credit Retention** Your institution provides the credit, so there is no issue of transfer.
- Internationalization Professional development for Faculty.
- **Simple** Once the program details have been agreed upon, AIFS will make all the on-site arrangements and help both faculty and students plan for their time abroad.

Support for faculty:

PRIOR TO DEPARTURE:

 Liaison with an experienced AIFS program manager to create an itinerary that fits with the course syllabus/learning outcomes

FLIGHTS:

 Option to include a stipend for faculty airfare or a space on the group flight

IN LOCATION:

- Accommodation in a centrally located apartment or hotel
- Full participation on all scheduled activities, inclusive of transfers, entrances, group meals etc.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT:

 Assistance in finding visits and/or guest speakers to compliment the course offered by US faculty



Optional Components:

ADDITIONAL EXCURSIONS:

 To locations within the same country or further afield (Prices vary)

GROUP TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE:

- Can include an optional or mandatory group flight
- Package includes meet and greet at overseas airport and transfers to and from accommodation
- Students indicate on their application and make payment online
- Base fare guaranteed, airline-imposed taxes and fees subject to change

(Airfare quotes available 11 months prior to departure)

OPTIONAL MEAL VOUCHER PACKAGE:

 Depending on location meal plans may be available for an additional fee (Prices vary)

*can be additional or can be included as part of the main program fee



Health & Safety:

- Our #1 priority is the health and safety of all students and faculty while on our programs.
- On-site orientation with local staff
- Additional workshops on safety and security, cultural differences
- Relationships with local emergency services medical, police
- 24/7 AIFS Emergency phone contact on site and in the US

- Emergency evacuation plan



Costs & Billing:

- The final student fee depends on student and enrolment and faculty/student ratio
- AIFS can work on any student/faculty ratio requested
- Financial Aid a separate payment schedule can be arranged for students on FA based on their loan disbursement dates. Dedicated staff in Stamford, CT to work with these students and assist with their finances.

Student fees can either be paid to AIFS by the individual student, or the institution can be invoiced for the group.


Things to remember:
