DESIGN A SEMESTER

Business Track:

3 Business courses + 3 Credit Internship = 12 Credit semester

3 Business courses + 1 Spanish course = 12 Credit semester

Business & Spanish Track:

2 Business courses + 2 Spanish courses = 12 Credit semester

2 Business courses + 1 Spanish course + 3 Credit Internship
= 12 Credit semester

Internship Track:

6 Credit Internship + 2 Spanish courses = 12 credit
semester

6 Credit Internship + 1 Business courses + 1 Independent
Study = 12 credit semester

6 Credit Internship + 1 Spanish course + 1 Independent
Study = 12 credit semester
