To be eligible, you must be in the process of applying for a CAPA program. See if you qualify and apply at capa.org/scholarships.



NEED-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications are evaluated based on financial need, as well as the student's reflection on identity, program goals, and personal investment.

BLOGGER AND VLOGGER GRANT

Each term, we select a team of bloggers, vloggers, and Instagram TV vloggers to share their study abroad experiences on the CAPA World Blog. Students receive the grant to help them explore their host city and fund their content creation.

DIVERSITY ADVOCATE GRANT

Eligible students must be committed and engaged, and already have a track record of successful advocacy for diversity in their campus and home communities. Successful applicants will demonstrate how their required project will impact both future CAPA programs and their home community once their study abroad experience is completed.

AFFILIATE SCHOOL GRANT

Over 200 colleges and universities are affiliated with CAPA. A benefit of affiliation provides students from these institutions with a special grant. If you are from an affiliate institution, you may automatically receive this grant for semester and/or summer programs.

STUDY AGAIN WITH CAPA GRANT

If you studied abroad before on any CAPA program, you will automatically receive this grant to study abroad again on a CAPA semester or summer program.

MY GLOBAL CITY EVENTS

The My Global City events calendar offers a wide-range of CAPA-led and self-led activities and social events each week.

CAPA-led events include festivals such as *La Mercé* in fall, Santa Eulalia in spring, and Sant Joan in summer; traditional Catalan cultural activities such as Sardanes (the Catalan dance of unity), *castellers* (human castles), and the *correfoc* (pyrotechnics with dragons and devils); a walking tour of the Born area, with its labyrinth of streets in the oldest quarter of the city; and a visit to Santa Maria del Mar, an excellent example of Catalan Gothic architecture and Barcelona's "forgotten" cathedral. Other activities vary by term. Volunteering opportunities may also be available.

SPRING, SUMMER, AND FALL TERMS

The Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF) is a tri-lingual university offering semester and summer programs taught in English in a variety of subjects, including Hispanic & European Studies, International Business, International Relations, Engineering, and Biomedical Sciences.

Choose courses across disciplines and engage in other academic opportunities, including independent research and language courses. Additional course offerings are available to students with Spanish and Catalan proficiency.

The CAPA UPF program includes comprehensive pre-departure support, orientation, welcome and farewell events, access to the CAPA Barcelona My Global City Calendar, and CAPA Emergency Services, including the CAPA Guardian App. In addition, take advantage of the activities, events, and support services provided by UPF.

UPF HOUSING & CAMPUS LIFE

- Live in shared student resident housing (self-catered) or choose a homestay (with your own room and two meals a day), all within commuting distance to campus.
- Immerse yourself in campus life by taking part in cultural, social, sports, and other extracurricular activities UPF offers.

MY GLOBAL CITY EVENTS

The My Global City events calendar offers a wide-range of CAPA-led and self-led activities and social events each week. CAPA-led activities each term include a tour of Buenos Aires' famous street murals and a visit to the Immigration Museum.

Mate on Tuesday is a weekly informal gathering where students can enjoy a favorite local beverage.

Other activities vary by term and may include visiting Teatro Colón, the Fiesta de Mataderos, an authentic gauchos "cowboy" fair, a street fair with live music, tango lessons, sporting events, language classes, and more.

The My Global City calendar also offers several opportunities for volunteering throughout the term.

Self-led events include visits to historic temples, and famous Shanghai parks and streets.
