Whether your major requires O Chem or you want to take it for science credit, this summer program gives you the opportunity to focus exclusively on Organic Chemistry in an international context. Tackle this challenging course in a small class setting, with personalized instructor attention at the University of Alicante. When you're not in class, enjoy the experience of life abroad in beautiful, coastal Alicante, a vacation destination attracting visitors from all over Europe with its white sand beaches and relaxed atmosphere.

Spanish faculty will teach your courses in English. You can complement your chemistry coursework with a Spanish culture course designed to align with university degree requirements.

- Demonstrate to future employers your 'international mindset' and ability to navigate cultural differences

## Learning About the Host City

CEA offers many opportunities to get outside of the classroom and learn about your host city. These include museum visits, hikes, and walking tours, just to name a few.

## **EXAMPLES OF PROGRAM ACTIVITIES**

- Rutas Alicantinas: These short walking tours are designed to acquaint you with the city and province of Alicante. You'll experience the city's surroundings, traditions, and festivities first-hand. On the Ruta: La Villa, you'll explore the "Jeweled Town," a village known for its brightly colored houses and outstanding chocolate. You'll also visit one of Spain's oldest chocolate factories, now El Museo de Chocolate, long the economic core of the city and exporter of fine chocolates.
- Hike to the Santa Barbara Castle: Located 545 feet up Mount Benacantil, the Santa Barbara Castle has overlooked the bay since the 9th century when the Iberian Peninsula was under Arabic control. You'll learn more about this historic castle and site, which has been used as a fortress and prison and reconstructed and abandoned many times until opening to the public in 1963.
