


Placement Methodology

All participants are guided through the placement process by a dedicated Admissions Advisor. The advisor personally discusses participant skills, experiences and student goals for the future to align with the final chosen host company. All information is then compiled with to support local business development teams to find a suitable placement.

Program Evaluation and Monitoring

To ensure continued success for our partners and their students we have embedded an evaluation system into all programming including pre- and post-program personal reflection exercises, weekly check-ins and a post-program debrief with all university partners.

Standard Programs

Students can apply directly to any of our standard CRCC Asia programs.

Many universities chose to promote our international internships as standard programs, and as such students can chose any location and program start date we receiving the standard \$200 university partner discount. CRCC Asia supports the university

standard programs, and as such students can chose any location and program start date while still receiving the standard \$200 university partner discount. CRCC Asia supports the university through recruitment and promotion efforts, coordinating the student applications, and managing all support pre-departure, on the ground, and upon return.

Custom Program Options

Many universities opt to send set cohorts of students (8-25) with a set start date and location to intern abroad with the support of CRCC Asia. CRCC Asia can be the sole support on location and not supported by a faculty-lead for custom program options. For these programs students will apply directly to their university and get selected through their chosen application process and metrics. CRCC Asia can support custom add-ons as simple as additional host company visits or as extensive as a cultural orientation week or language immersion program. Some of our current custom program offerings are noted below.

Language Intensives

Students are able to attend 2-4 weeks of intensive Mandarin Lessons prior to beginning their 4 - 8 week internship. This program is offered in all three China locations including: Beijing, Shanghai, and Shenzhen.

Throughout the language program and internship

the student is fully sup-

ported by CRCC Asia.

Cultural Orientations

Option to add on single or multi-day cultural excursions before or during the internship program.

These can include:

- Camping on the Great Wall of China
- Full day City tour
- Cultural workshops and additional activities.
- Multi-city exploration

Professional Immersion

Opportunity to schedule additional support events to further a students professional experience.

These can include:

- Company visits of 1— 3 companies in a day
- Additional networking event
- Sector specific half or full day business seminars.

Semester Internships

CRCC Asia can support internship placements to complement an existing semester long exchange. Students will work 1 or 2 days a week throughout their term and CRCC Asia only supports the internship placement with accommodation and additional programming supported by the local university or exchange partner.

Faculty-led Program Options

Faculty-led trips can benefit from CRCC Asia's rich and diverse program locations lending well to specific majors and concentrations while taking advantage of our expertise in professional development and 850+ host company network allowing for expertise embedded into events, site visits, and more.

Internship Add-ons

CRCC Asia can offer internship add-ons to existing faculty-led trips to any of our program locations. This give an opportunity to students to further their location knowledge and immersion taking what they learned in the classroom and applying it to work. In other instances CRCC Asia can support professional development events or company site visits throughout at existing faculty-led course.

Full Program Support

CRCC Asia can offer full and holistic programming support for faculty-led trips including provision of classroom space, welcome orientations, cultural events, multi-city excursions and more. Many faculty choose to lead the trip for the first part leaving when the participants transfer to their internships or 1-3 weeks after. We support many custom and faculty-led trips with examples on the following page.

Business in Shanghai

CRCC Asia is supporting 20 students from a College of Business and 2 Faculty members on a multi-city faculty-led trip through China. The trips begins with a week in Beijing, where students will participate in morning lectures at various co-working spaces followed by either host company visits or a cultural events. Highlights will include a dumpling making lesson, Beijing Day tour and a trip to the Great Wall of China. From Beijing the group with head on an overnight train to Xi'an to see the Terracotta Warriors and countryside, before heading for a second week in Shanghai following a similar schedule of Beijing. After the full 14 days of travel, class, and adventure the faculty leaders will head home while the students begin a six week full-time internship placement.

Engineering in Shenzhen

With the support of faculty leaders 15 students joined us this past summer for a cultural orientation week in China, followed by 1 month of classes at Tsinghua University in Shenzhen. The trip culminates with faculty heading home and interns settling in to apply what they learned in the classroom to a four week internship focused on engineering. While the students are on the ground a full 9 weeks, CRCC Asia directly supports the welcome orientation week and the 4 weeks of internships, providing only ad hoc 24/7 emergency support while students live at Tsinghua and study. The faculty-led trip is a great balance between cultural exploration, coursework, and experiential learning.

Internship Add-on to Existing Faculty-led Program

Many faculty-led trips have been fine tuned and honed over the years allowing students high impact exploration in under three weeks. Adding the optional addition of an 4-8 week internship following the trip allows students to apply what they learned during the faculty-led portion of a trip to a full-time work experience. CRCC Asia has sector specific placements that can readily align to most faculty-led content and help support additional elements such as visas, cultural events, business seminars, company visits and more during the faculty-led portion.

We began working with CRCC Asia in 2016 with the goal of introducing a new university internship program in Beijing, China.
