

Online Master's Degree Industrial Organizational Psychology

At Saint Peter's University students will have the opportunity of either obtaining a MA or MS depending on their intended career pathway. Both options require completion of 36 credits. The MA option involves a 3-credit capstone project as part of their electives. For the MS, students will complete a 6-credit thesis sequence that culminates with a successful defense of a thesis paper/project.
