SEMESTER PROGRAMS

PERTH, AUSTRALIA | MURDOCH UNIVERSITY

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$14,795 | Credits: up to 16 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.5 GPA Overview:

- » Exercise Science Internship course providing students with practical and professional experience in the field of sports science. The course carries a recommended 4 credits
- » Students will complete up to 120 hours of practical work experience (un-paid). This experience may include working within a gym setting, sporting team, clinic, or providing assistance to ongoing research within the fields of Sport and Exercise Science
- » Available in the Full Curriculum Program in which students take up to 4 courses.
- Other health and sport related courses available include sports and exercise psychology, introduction to sports science, exercise programming and prescription
- » Excursions to Fremantle, Cottesloe Beach, Caversham Wildlife Park and others included
- WOLLONGONG, AUSTRALIA | UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$18,995 | Credits: Up to 16 | Eligibility: Open to sophomore or junior business or commerce majors. Minimum 2.7 GPA

Courses: art history, business, communications, design and media, economics, education, finance, history, international relations, political science and social sciences

Overview:

» Take a 3-credit Business Internship course and one other course from the faculty of Business, plus one or two more courses to make up a full-time load

- Optional Pacific Studies Program in Fiji as well as other optional trips within Australia
- » A 4 credit Public Policy Internship course is also available. This is a cooperative arrangement with the Western Australia State Parliament and Western Australian Public Service.
- » Students will undertake research under the collective guidance of a Member of Parliament (MP)/public sector representative and a Murdoch University academic supervisor.
- » Assessment is a combination of participation in the placement, a research project and a presentation.

- » Spend 16 days in the workplace (in addition to in-class learning and assessments)
- 3-day orientation in Sydney, Blue Mountains excursion and optional Pacific Studies Program in Fiji.

SAN JOSÉ, COSTA RICA | UNIVERSIDAD VERITAS

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$11,695 | Credits: Up to 19 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.6 GPA. Students must be 20 years of age by the start of the internship and have 2 years of college level Spanish (or equivalent) and place into Advanced level Spanish. Minimum 2 years college-level Spanish. Minimum 5 completed courses in subject area of internship

Courses: architecture, art, business, communications, economics, environmental science, health, history, linguistics, literature, Spanish language and more

- » Students take one Spanish course for 5 semester credits, one internship for a recommended 4 semester credits, an independent study course for 3 semester credits and if their schedule permits they may be able to take one or two additional classes
- » Minimum of 30 hours per week with companies or NGOs in the vicinity of Universidad Veritas
- » Previous placements have been in schools, a laboratory, an international exchange office, the travel and tourism industry and digital companies
- » Day trip visit to Poás Volcano, a 3-day trip to Manuel Antonio National Park and a 3-day visit to Arenal Volcano, Hot Springs and Monteverde Cloud Forest



PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC | CHARLES UNIVERSITY

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$14,295 | Credits: Up to 18 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 3.0 GPA

Courses: art and culture, Czech language, economics, history, literature, politics, psychology, sociology

Overview:

- » A 3-credit internship, offered and accredited by Richmond, the American International University in London.
- » Interns will be engaged in different fields ranging from production, marketing, IT and administrative assistant placements with the Prague Shakespeare Company to teaching English in a local elementary school
- » Students must attend interviews with suitable organizations; this is a competitive process
- » On the Internship Program students will: Experience and participate in international, intercultural learning and friendships, develop personal skills and

strengths that improve confidence as well as future, employment opportunities, work in a different culture, develop a strong résumé, participate in career opportunity networking

- » In addition to working and attending internship seminars, students submit a weekly journal recording duties and learning as well as an analysis of specified aspects of the work experience
- » In addition to the internship students select up to 4 courses from the Eastern and Central European Studies Program (ECES) or Charles University
- » 2-day excursion to Moravia and two day trips to places like Plzen, Kutna Hora or Terezin. Optional excursions to Kraków and Auschwitz, Poland, Budapest, Hungary, Vienna, Austria, Southern Bohemia and Salzburg, Austria and Czech spa town and hiking excursion.

PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC | UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS (VŠE)

Offered: Fall or spring semester | Fee: \$14,295 | Credits: Up to 15 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 3.0* GPA.

Courses: business, Czech language, economics, finance, global studies, history, management, marketing and politics, psychology

Overview:

- » A 3-credit internship, offered and accredited by Richmond, the American International University in London. In addition to the internship, students select up to 4 courses from the Central and Eastern European Studies Program (CESP) at the University of Economics.
- » Interns will be engaged in different fields ranging from production, marketing, IT and administrative assistant placements with the Prague Shakespeare Company to

teaching English in a local elementary school. Students may work in small or large organizations, located in different areas of the city.

- » 2-day excursion to Moravia and two day trips to places like Plzen, Kutna Hora or Terezin. Optional excursions to Kraków and Auschwitz, Poland, Budapest, Hungary, Vienna, Austria, Southern Bohemia and Salzburg, Austria and Czech spa town and hiking excursion.
- *2.7 GPA and above will be considered on a case by case basis

LONDON, ENGLAND | RICHMOND, THE AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY IN LONDON

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$16,495 | Credits: 12 | Eligibility: Open to college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.75 GPA for students with at least 75 semester credits; minimum 3.0 GPA for students with between 45 and 74 semester credits (3.0 for all students seeking a place in finance or political science; 3.2 for psychology). Paid or unpaid work experience during the last two years, one letter of reference from a former employer/supervisor, two letters of academic reference from a former professor/ advisor

Courses: accounting, American studies, art, design and media, art history, British studies, business, communications, creative writing, development studies, economics, entrepreneurship, European studies, fashion, film, finance, history, international business, international journalism, international relations, literature, management, marketing, media studies, photography, politics, public relations, psychology, religion, service learning, sociology and theater

- » 6-credit internship course and a 4-day per week (for 8 weeks) internship placement
- » 3-credit Contemporary British Culture course plus an additional 3-credit course for a total of 12 credits
- » Placements in the fields of art and design, business, finance and accounting, communications and PR, fashion and beauty and more
- » Day trips to Stonehenge, Salisbury, and Cambridge, cultural activities and optional excursion to Paris

FLORENCE, ITALY | RICHMOND UNIVERSITY IN FLORENCE

Offered: Fall or Spring | **Fee:** \$16,495 | **Credits:** Up to 13 | **Eligibility:** Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.75 GPA for students with 75 or more semester credits; a minimum 3.0 GPA for students with between 45 and 74 semester credits (3.0 for all students seeking placements in finance and political science)

Overview:

- » Mandatory Italian language for a total of 3 credits, a 3 credit, unpaid, résuméenhancing internship and two or three additional 3-credit courses related to the chosen internship chosen from the Traditional Academic Program
- » Students may also choose an additional 1-credit optional Introduction to Italian Art course, taught only during the field trips to Rome and Venice, for a total of 13 credits
- » Placements available in art history, art, design and media, communications, economics, education, international business, management and tourism
- » 3-day trip to Rome, a 2-day trip to Venice and a day trip to Siena

ROME, ITALY | RICHMOND UNIVERSITY IN ROME

Offered: Fall or Spring | **Fee:** \$15,595 | **Credits:** From 12 to 16 | **Eligibility:** Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.75 GPA for students with at least 75 semester credits; Minimum 3.0 GPA for students with 45-74 semester credits (3.0 GPA for all students seeking placements in finance and political science).

Overview:

- » Students in the Internship Program take 3 or 6 credits in Italian language, carry out a 3- or 6-credit unpaid internship placement and take 1 or 2 additional 3- or 6-credit courses related to their internship.
- » Optional Introduction to Italian Art 1 credit course, taught during the field trips to Naples and Florence
- » Placements available in Art, Design and Media, Art History, Business,

PARIS, FRANCE | THE AMERICAN BUSINESS SCHOOL

Offered: Spring only | **Fee:** \$23,495 | **Credits:** Up to 24 | **Eligibility:** Open to college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.8 GPA. Students must have a minimum Intermediate level French (or be enrolled in Elementary French during the semester) in order to participate in the internship.

Courses: FREN290 Business French (1) and BUSI390 Company Case Challenge (2)

Overview:

» Earn credit for a 2-month unpaid internship in Paris after completing the International Business and Humanities program in the spring. Students will take up to five courses in the spring semester alongside two mandatory career development courses. During the semester, to develop their understanding of French professional life and develop opportunities for their internships, students will also be required to attend Career Management Development workshops, an individual coaching session with the ABS Paris Head of Career Development,

- Communications, Economics, Education, Film Studies, Finance, Food Studies, History, International Business, International Relations, Management and Tourism, Marketing, Museum Studies, Political Science, Social Science
- » 3-day trip to Florence, a 3-day trip to Naples and Pompeii and a day trip to Assisi and the Umbria region

- networking conferences and corporate lectures. After the semester ends, students will work full time in an internship placement for 2 months earning an additional 6 credits 4 for BUSI220 Internship and 2 for BUSI222 which involves 2 hours of tutoring and an internship report.
- » Internships are available in business development, hospitality, marketing, retail management and tourism.
- » Visit to the Palace of Versailles and other visits which may include Monet's gardens in Giverny and the Château de Vaux le Vicomte. Optional excursion to Normandy and Brittany.

WELLINGTON, NEW ZEALAND | VICTORIA UNIVERSITY

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$18,995 | Credits: Up to 16 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.7 GPA.

- » The internship course carries 5 credits and students combine this with courses from the Full Curriculum program at Victoria University.
- » Students will complete a work-based project while on a voluntary placement arranged by the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences.
- » 3-day excursion to Rotorua and a range of other cultural activities. Optional Pacific Studies Program in Fiji.

GRANADA, SPAIN | UNIVERSITY OF GRANADA

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$10,995 | Credits: Up to 15 | Eligibility: Open to high school graduates, college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.5 GPA, minimum Upper Intermediate level Spanish required

Overview:

- » Internship placements are available in local businesses, a private hospital shadowing and working with healthcare professionals, in an NGO or as a student teacher in a local school
- » Students accepted onto the program will complete a 3-credit, 45 hour total or a 7-credit, 120 hour total internship, group seminars and individual meetings with the University of Granada Internship Coordinator, presentation of an internship diary and give an oral presentation
- » Required Spanish Speaking and Writing Skills course. Spanish Grammar is also required for upper Intermediate and low Advanced level students. For the remaining 2 or 3 electives students can choose courses from the Spanish

MADRID, SPAIN | UNIVERSIDAD NEBRIJA

Language and Culture Programs in Spanish or courses from the Advanced Hispanic Studies Program

- » 120 hour internship for an optional fee of \$525 (not available for students interning in an NGO)
- » 3-day excursion to Gibraltar, Seville and Córdoba, day trips and optional excursions to Madrid and Toledo and Morocco

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$14,995 | Credits: Up to 15 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.75 GPA. Students must have a minimum High Intermediate level Spanish in order to participate in the internship. Intermediate level students wishing to take their internship in the science or hospitality field will be considered on a case by case basis.

Overview:

- » The Internship carries 3 credits and students combine this with courses from the Hispanic Studies program. Students take up to 4 courses full time for the first two months and then spend the remainder of the program doing their internship. Students wishing to extend their internship beyond the length of their AIFS program can do so by arrangement with Nebrija University. Students would need to arrange their own housing.
- » Internships have been offered in accounting, architecture, art gallery/museums, arts, music, performing arts, arts restoration, biology, environment (animal protection), chemical and bio-sectors, education in NGO and schools, engineering,

SALAMANCA, SPAIN | UNIVERSITY OF SALAMANCA

hotels and restaurants, hotel-tourism, human resources, law, marketing, media and journalism, psychology (only in occupational support activities, not psychological) public relations, social work, special education, sports, theater and travel agencies

- » All interns take part in an intercultural competence seminar
- » 3-day excursion to Granada and day trips to Segovia, Toledo and El Escorial and an optional excursions to Morocco and Salamanca.

Offered: Fall or Spring | Fee: \$11,995 + \$550 internship supplement | Credits: Up to 15 | Eligibility: Open to high school graduates, college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Students must have a minimum Upper Intermediate level Spanish or above in order to participate in the internship

Overview:

- » Students with an interest in a teaching career will have the opportunity to work in a local Spanish school assisting teachers and supporting students in English language classes.
- » Students will complete a 3-credit, 45-hour total internship in addition to 4 courses from their chosen academic program. The program includes individual meetings with University of Salamanca staff to prepare students and support them through the internship.
- » Day trip to Segovia, a wine tasting day trip to Toro an important wine region in Zamora, and a 3-day excursion to Lisbon, Portugal. Optional excursions to Barcelona and Marrakesh, Morocco.

VALENCIA, SPAIN | UNIVERSIDAD CATÓLICA DE VALENCIA

Offered: Fall or Spring | **Fee:** \$13,495 | **Credits:** 12 | **Eligibility:** Open to college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Internships are available in English and Spanish. Some internships in Spanish will require and Advanced level of proficiency. Some internships may require an additional fee, please contact the AIFS Admissions Officer for further information.

- » The UCV-US Program offers internship positions in areas ranging from health clinics, hospitals and business to social services and teacher education. Recent internship placements have been available in the following fields: biotechnology, marine sciences, education teaching practice, nursing, medicine (hospital), early childhood intervention, physiotherapy.
- » Students earn a minimum of 3 credits during the internship through their academic department.
- » This is a competitive program with limited placements, and we recommend that you apply early.
- » Day trips to the wine region of Valencia, Albufera National Park and a 2-night excursion to Spain's capital city, Madrid. Optional excursion to Tangier and Tetouan, Morocco.

BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA | UNIVERSITY OF BELGRANO

Medical Spanish Immersion Program

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$6,995 | Credits: Up to 6 | Eligibility: Open to sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.75 GPA. Minimum Intermediate Spanish language required

Overview:

- » This Medical Spanish Immersion Program is designed primarily for those interested in a career in the health professions
- » In addition to Spanish language classes focusing on improving medical vocabulary and lectures from health professionals, students take a clinical rotation internship at the Hospital Británico in Buenos Aires providing them with a unique, hands-on learning opportunity
- » Students will be assigned to specific medical areas at the hospital such as Pediatrics, Intensive Care Unit, Internal Medicine, Emergency Room, Infectious Diseases, Orthopedics and Traumatology

Spanish Language with Teaching Assistant Placement Program

- » Course work includes medical vocabulary and lectures on local healthcare. By the end of this 6-credit program students will have improved their Spanish language skills, built relationships with medical professionals and gained experience in medical and research environments in Argentina
- » Day trip to Colonia del Sacramento, Uruguay, Fiesta Gaucha and an optional 3-day trip to Iguazú Falls
- Offered: Summer | Fee: \$6,495 | Credits: Up to 8 | Eligibility: Open to sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.75 GPA. Minimum Intermediate Spanish language required

- » The program combines a teaching assistant placement in a bilingual primary school with a course in teaching Spanish as a second language
- » Combination of theoretical instruction and practical experience will increase students understanding of second language acquisition and teaching methodology
- » Transcript will show 60 contact hours for each course
- » Day trip to Colonia del Sacramento, Uruguay, Fiesta Gaucha, and an optional 3-day trip to Iguazú Falls

LONDON, ENGLAND | RICHMOND, THE AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY IN LONDON

Regular Internship Program

Offered: Summer | Fee: 9 weeks: \$9,695, 12 weeks: \$10,695* | Credits: Up to 12 | Eligibility: Open to college juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.75 GPA for students with 75 or more semester credits; a minimum 3.0 GPA for students with between 45 and 74 semester credits, 3.0 for all students seeking placements in finance and political science; 3.2 in psychology

Overview:

- » Designed to provide an integrated learning experience of a high academic standard, combining classroom study and an internship placement in London, one of the world's major political, financial and cultural centers
- » Required Contemporary British Culture course plus one other course offered on the 9-week program in addition to working 3 days per week for 6 weeks on an internship placement
- » On the 12-week program, take 2 courses for the first six weeks and then work fulltime in an internship placement for the final 6 weeks
- » Guided city tour of London, walking tours. theater visits, and day trips. An optional excursion to Paris

BERLIN, GERMANY | FREIE UNIVERSITÄT BERLIN

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$8,895* | Credits: Earn up to 6 credits | Eligibility: Open to college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 3.0 GPA. No previous German language study required, although students with some German knowledge will have access to a wider choice of placements

Overview:

- » The 8-week, full-time (35-40 hours per week) internship allows students to enrich their academic experience in Berlin by immersing themselves in a German workplace and gaining valuable intercultural experience along with skills for their careers. Internships are sought with organizations and companies in Berlin that match each student's professional and academic background, previous work experience and career goals. Each internship placement is arranged on an individual basis
- » In addition to the internship placement, students are required to attend specifically designed classroom-based weekly seminars which cover topics such as working life in Germany, personal organization, identifying one's goals and expectations, communication and etiquette in the workplace, the German work ethic, hierarchies, cultural differences, etc. A written report about the experience is required at the end of the internship
- » Day trips to Potsdam and the Baltic sea

FLORENCE, ITALY | RICHMOND UNIVERSITY IN FLORENCE

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$8,495 | Credits: Up to 7 | Eligibility: Open to college juniors and seniors. Open to students with a minimum 45 credits completed by the start of the program. Minimum 2.75 GPA. No previous Italian language required

- » The Internship Program in Florence will focus on the fields of hospitality, fashion, tourism management and Italian food and wine culture with the purpose of providing students with the necessary skills and expertise for management, marketing and operations positions in the expanding tourism and food services industry
- » Students will take a 3-credit course chosen from the regular Maymester program (Painting in Florence, Italian Food and Culture or Psychology of Fashion) alongside a 3-day per week internship
- » May include day trips to places such as Pisa, Siena, and Lucca. Optional excursion to Venice and Rome.



ROME, ITALY | RICHMOND UNIVERSITY IN ROME

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$8,795 | Credits: up to 7 | Eligibility: Open to college juniors and seniors. Open to students with a minimum 45 credits completed by the start of the program. Minimum of 2.75 GPA. No previous Italian language required

Overview:

- » With its countless artistic and historical opportunities, Rome is the perfect location for this experience
- » Students spend their time balancing classroom based study and research with a 3-credit work placement in a museum, gallery, company or cultural institution in Rome plus one 3-credit course from the regular program
- » 2-day excursion to Florence and optional visits to Venice, Pompeii, Vesuvius, Sorrento, Naples and Capri

GRANADA, SPAIN | UNIVERSITY OF GRANADA

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$8,995 | Credits: Up to 13 | Eligibility: Open to high school graduates, college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.0 GPA, Minimum Intermediate level of Spanish

Overview:

- » Business internship Students must have an upper advanced level of Spanish. Working in local hotels students gain insight into the tourism and hospitality business in Spain
- » Medical internship Students must have an upper advanced level of Spanish. Students work in a private hospital shadowing and working with healthcare professionals
- » NGO Intermediate level of Spanish required. Students intern with a local organization supporting immigrant women

MADRID, SPAIN | UNIVERSIDAD NEBRIJA

Offered: Summer Sessions 1+2 Combined | Fee: \$8,995 | Credits: Up to 9 | Eligibility: Open to college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Students must have a minimum B1/202 level Spanish in order to participate in the internship

Overview:

- » Combines Session 1 of the Hispanic Studies program followed by a 4-week internship in a professional setting.
- » Internships are offered in professional fields including Business, Technical fields, Tourism and Hospitality, Engineering, Public Relations, Education. Students can earn up to 9 credits.

- » The internship is 3-credits. In addition students select courses from the Spanish Language and Culture Program for up to 6.5 credits per session
- » Students must attend interviews with suitable organizations as part of the internship selection process
- » Day trips such as the Costa del Sol, Seville, and Córdoba

» Guided day trips to Segovia, El Escorial and Toledo



INTERNSHIPS WITH GLOBAL EXPERIENCES



Live abroad and gain the international internship experience you need to get hired in today's increasingly globalized economy. You have your very own set of talents, experiences, and personality traits that no one else can exactly duplicate, but how do you prove that to employers? An internship is a great opportunity to gain work experience, and working in a new environment enhances those professional skills with attributes of adaptability and self-reliance. Global Experiences' programs provide the opportunity for participants to have the overseas adventure they want while simultaneously getting the experience they need.

Global Experiences offers internship programs lasting between 8 weeks in the summer and 12 to 14 weeks in the semester. Along with a guaranteed full-time internship in your career field, interns are provided with central accommodation, cultural and social events, day trips, and 24/7 on the ground support. GE also provides career and professional development before, during, and after the internship. Beginning with the CliftonStrengths assessment, a coaching call with a Gallup-Certified Strengths Coach, and resume and cover letter review, interns will have networking opportunities on location, a re-entry program that includes a certificate of completion, an optional 30-minute career readiness session with a Gallup coach, and an alumni guide which will assist in articulating their experience in an interview, building a brand, and maximizing their network.

BARCELONA, SPAIN

Term: Fall, Spring, Summer | **Eligibility:** No visa required for under 90 days for US, EU, and Canadian citizens. Must be a full time student.

Courses: business, economics, fine arts, French language, history, literature, political science and sociology

Overview:

- » On the French Language and Culture or Intensive French Language Programs, students can take a 3-credit service learning component in addition to the standard program courses
- » Students will design and run English language workshops for French high school students. They will work with local university professors to prepare the workshops and activities, prepare a research paper and give a presentation at the end of the course as well as spending time in a French High School working with local students
- » This is a wonderful opportunity for students to fully engage with the local community while gaining valuable skills and experience working with international colleagues

- » Designed for students with High Intermediate Spanish who wish to improve their language skills while also undertaking a community service placement
- » Over 8 weeks students take Sessions 1 and 2 of the Intensive Spanish Language Program alongside 60 hours of working in the local community. Students do the service learning part of the Program in the afternoon while taking an intensive Spanish course in the mornings
- » Placements available in the fields of health, science and technology, education, ecology and the environment
- » Students will be fully immersed in the culture enabling them to develop their communication skills and foster global perspectives and relationships through interaction with the people and culture of Argentina
- » Colonia del Sacramento, Uruguay (day trip) and Fiesta Gaucha (day trip)

ROME, ITALY | RICHMOND UNIVERSITY IN ROME

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$8,795 | Credits: Up to 10 | Eligibility: Open to high school graduates, college freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.75 GPA. Open to students with a minimum 45 credits completed by the start of the program

Overview:

- » The Service Learning Program combines a community placement with academic work, designed to allow students of all majors to gain valuable life experience, learn more about one of the biggest social and political issues of the day and contribute in a positive way to the community they are living and studying in. It is based on the principles of civic engagement, ethical social responsibility and social justice
- » The assessment is based on reflective learning, social analysis and public problem solving
- » Italy is one of the main points of entry for refugees and migrants trying to reach Europe, many fleeing war and persecution in their home countries. Students will learn more about this humanitarian crisis in lectures which supplement the service learning course
- » Day trip visits to museums and galleries, monuments, and wine tasting. Optional excursion to Venice and Sorrento

STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA | STELLENBOSCH UNIVERSITY

Offered: Summer | Fee: \$6,495 | Credits: Up to 8 | Eligibility: Open to college sophomores, juniors and seniors. Minimum 2.8 GPA

- » The Global Service Learning Program provides students with the opportunity to demonstrate their global citizenship through a service learning experience
- » Students will develop an understanding of the current issues impacting community life in South Africa and experience it first-hand through service to the community
- » Students will take a mandatory Introduction to South Africa's Political History course and Global Service Learning includes a placement in the community
- » Past projects have included working with children or adults teaching life skills, contributing to global awareness programs and teaching art, sport and general learning skills.
- » Vineyard tours, sports events, hiking, a West Coast weekend, visits to Cape Town and Table Mountain, Robben Island, Cape of Good Hope and an optional 6-day excursion along the Garden Route.
