# Be FULFILLED

*Access all the financial aid you're entitled to.*

The U.S. military will pay between 88 percent and 100 percent\* of your tuition for your bachelor's degree completion program at Bellevue University. To qualify, you must have two years' active duty and be approved for Tuition Assistance, and you must have contributed to the GI Bill fund.

\* The actual percentage of tuition paid by the U.S. military depends on the date of enrollment.

### *Using Veterans Educational Benefits.*

Your tuition funding at Bellevue University is available on a partial or full reimbursement basis. To be eligible for this reimbursement you must enroll in a Bellevue University bachelor's degree completion program. Each course taken must be completed before the end of the VA quarter in which you started the course.

**A dedicated VA rep is on staff to help you with your VA needs, including National Guard or Reserve benefits.**

### *Using Tuition Assistance and Top-Up funding.*

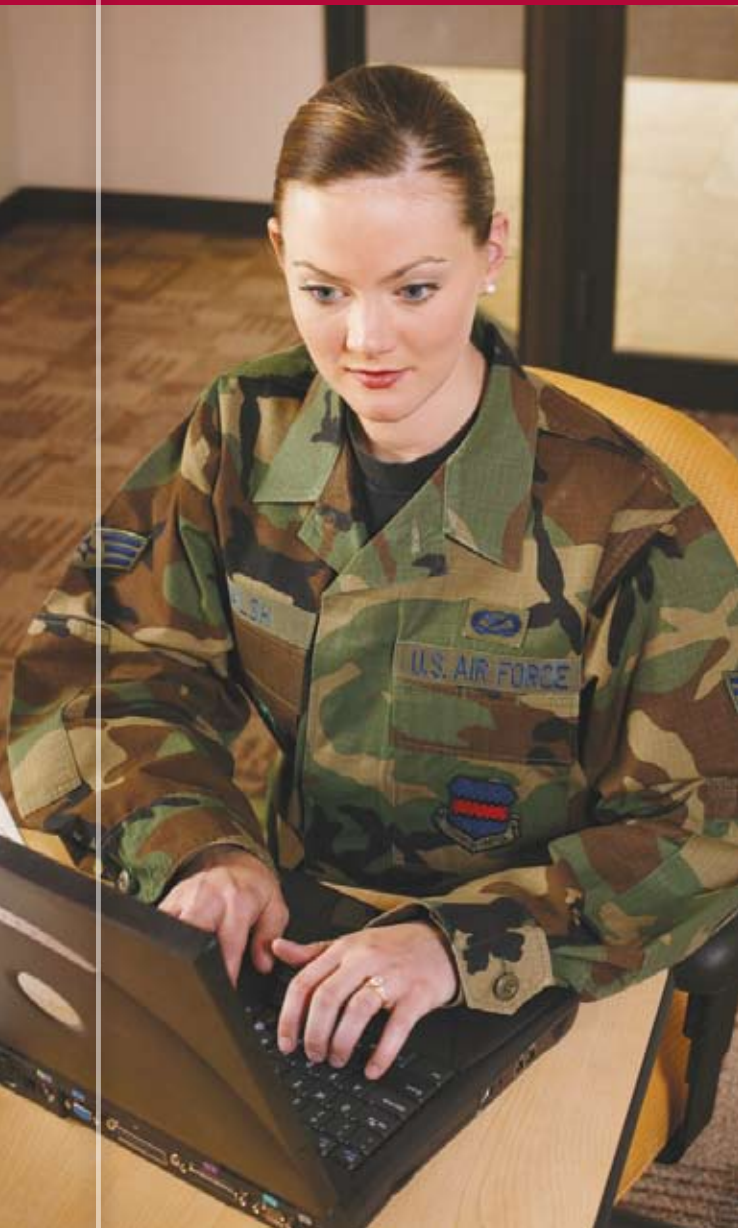
At a cost of \$350 per credit hour, Bellevue University online tuition is among the most affordable available. Military tuition assistance will pay for \$250 per credit hour taken (up to a total of \$4,500 per fiscal year). This assistance can be supplemented with the "Top-Up" program, which will cover the remaining costs of your tuition. ("Top-Up" funds are meant to supplement tuition assistance, so they are only available when using tuition assistance.) Taken together, tuition assistance and "Top-Up" funds will pay for 100 percent of your college tuition, up to the above stated maximum.
