- NIH Neuroscience Blueprint Infant & Toddler Toolbox
 - 5 yr. Contract awarded Sept 2019 to Northwestern University (PI: R. Gershon)
 - 1-42 months old, normed assessment of cognition, language, socioemotional, and self-regulation development via a new iPad app
 - Measurements of assessed areas correspond to 3 -85 yrs. NIH Toolbox assessments
- NIH Neuroscience Blueprint Toolbox
 - Contract awarded to move existing NIH Toolbox to "cellphone mobile" platform
- NIH BRAIN Initiative (<u>https://braininitiative.nih.gov/</u>)





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New Job Opportunities at NIH (p1)

All Federal Hiring goes through <u>USAjobs.gov</u>

- Begin by creating your online profile at USAjobs.gov
- Prepare and upload your resume (CV) in the USAjobs.gov format
- Set your job alert parameters (locale, minimum and target GSlevels, etc.)
- Job announcements are typically on the street for a very short time (~1 week) so be ready to quickly respond to a desirable announcement
- Talk to a current Program Director to learn the computer triage tips & hurdles *before* starting your application

develop a portfolio of interdisciplinary research on typical and atypical early neurodevelopment that capitalizes on technological advances in neuroimaging, neuro-genomics, and neuro-assessment to examine interrelated developmental changes in brain structure and function, gene regulation and expression, and complex behavior and cognition, in both human and comparative neurobiology studies.

deep knowledge of research in developmental psychology, linguistics, and cognitive neuroscience—especially in pediatric populations—to develop and maintain a research portfolio that supports and encourages research on the neurodevelopmental, social and environmental factors that impair or enhance the developmental trajectories supporting bilingual development in the home and community settings
