PROGRAM SNAPSHOT

Offered in Russia (**Moscow, St. Petersburg, Vladimir**) and Kazakhstan (**Almaty**)

20 hours per week of **intensive coursework** in Russian grammar, conversation, phonetics, and mass media, as well as Russian literature, history, and politics

Small class sizes (4–6 students); all courses taught in Russian

Cultural activities and **extended regional field study excursions**

Housing with **host families** or in **university dormitories**

Pre-departure orientation in Washington, DC and **in-country orientation**

2 semesters of college-level Russian or the equivalent

Minimum 2.7 GPA

Age 18+ by application deadline
