ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Duration: 15 Weeks.

All students must register for at least one Spanish course and one Anthropology course.

Spanish Course: Elementary Spanish M01, Elementary Spanish M02, Intermediate Spanish M03, Intermediate Spanish M04. All Spanish courses are **5 units**.

** You can take two consecutive Spanish courses during your stay in Quito.

Anthropology: Sex, Gender, and Culture M09; Magic, Witchcraft, and Religion M11. All Anthropology courses are **3 units**.

"You can enroll in both courses at the same time. You can add any (or all) of the online courses available: Cultural Anthropology MO2, Peoples and Cultures of the World MO7.

Service Learning: 1 -3 units.

3 Cultural excursions

30% payment must be received at the time of booking. Total payment must be made 6 weeks before arrival.

Program fee does not include: plane ticket, personal expenses, Visas, Moorpark tuition and course units.

Students will have the opportunity to take additional **online courses** at Moorpark College during their stay in Quito.

- **30% first payment:** February 15th, 2020 (1,329 USD)
- · **30% second payment:** April 15th, 2020 (1,329 USD)
- $\textbf{40\% third payment:} \ June \ 15^{th}, \ 2020 \ (1,772 \ USD)$
- For cancellations made before **April 24th**, 2020 90% of the payment will be refunded.
- For cancellations made before **June 24th**, 2020 70% of the payment will be refunded.
- For cancellations made before **July 24**th, 2020 50% of the payment will be refunded. After July 25th there will be no cancellation refund.
