

### **ELIGIBILITY**

You can apply to study abroad at HebrewU if:

- You've completed at least 28 credits from an accredited college or university
- The language of instruction at your college or university is English (or you have a minimum TOEFL score of 89)
- Your cumulative GPA is at least 3.0 (B)

Additional prerequisites vary by program.
