
Day 1

Arrive into London Heathrow airport and meet our in-country coordinator. Transfer to accommodation followed by a walking tour of central London. In the evening, the group will enjoy a 3-course welcome dinner in a typical British restaurant.

Day 2

In-depth orientation with our local coordinator, followed by a visit to the Tate Modern Museum. Afternoon spent with London Youth Young Culture Makers Program.

The story continues on stage! The group will spend the afternoon at the theater enjoying Harry Potter & the Cursed Child, Parts 1 & 2.



Day 4

Tour of British Parliament followed by a meeting with activists from Advocacy Academy.

Day 5

Camden Street Art Tour followed by a visit to the Cartoon Museum, and then the House of Minalima. In the afternoon, the group will visit the SkyGarden and take in the beautiful views of London.

Day 6

Harry Potter Walking Tour followed by a visit to either the Tower of London or London Dungeons.

Day 7

The group will tour the Warner Bros Studio to get a behind-the-scenes look at how the movies were made.

Day 8

The group will take the train to Edinburgh, the capital of Scotland. Day 9

Walking tour of Central Edinburgh, followed by a guided tour of Edinburgh Castle.

Day 10

Guided tour of Scottish Parliament, followed by a meeting with members of the Scottish Youth Parliament. In the evening, the group will enjoy a Harry Potter-themed comedy/improv show.

Dav 11

Harry Potter Walking Tour, followed by a hike to Arthur's seat depending on weather.

Day 12

Optional tour of Holyrood House, followed by a free afternoon to enjoy Edinburgh, before enjoying a 3-course farewell dinner.

Day 13

Transfer to Edinburgh Airport for flight home.

Program Features

A. Pre-Departure Support

Comprehensive pre-departure support from World Endeavors staff members, including a pre-departure orientation or webinar as requested. Participants will also receive a personalized pre-departure handbook.

B. 24 hour UK-based support

The group will be chaperoned by a World Endeavors representative throughout the trip.

C. In-Country Orientation

In-Depth in-country orientation introducing the group to British culture, health and safety issues, and the schedule for the program.

D. Group Accommodations

Students will stay in shared rooms in local hotels, separated by gender. Faculty will have private rooms.

E. Meals

A basic breakfast will be included each day in addition to a welcome dinner and farewell dinner. Students will be given 10GBP for lunch and 20GBP for dinner each day.

F. Entrance Fees and Theater Tickets

All entrance fees will be included, as well as theater tickets for Harry Potter & the Cursed Child, Parts 1 & 2.

G. In-Country Transportation including London Travel Card

To be a mixture of train and coach travel. In London, participants will be given their own oyster card loaded with credit.

H. Airport Reception and Drop-off

Pickup from London Heathrow Airport and drop off at Edinburgh International Airport.
