Authority on Demand (AOD) is a unique product for controlling user permissions while flexibly responding to the ever-changing security needs of an organization. Authority on Demand performs real-time audit of access rights in order to protect sensitive corporate assets. It reduces the number of profiles with high-level authorities, while enabling relevant personnel to easily obtain access to approved information upon demand, saving valuable time and resources. In direct response to the growing security-related concerns of enterprises and auditor's demand, AOD uses advanced logging and reporting facilities in order to tighten controls over the allocation of special authorities.

- **Easy to Use** - AOD simplifies the process of granting special authorities when necessary, and incorporates advanced reporting and monitoring mechanisms.
- **Add/Swap Security Levels (unique to iSecurity™ AOD)** - AOD can grant alternative security authority level or add additional security rights on request.
- **Authority Transfer Rules & Providers** - AOD enables pre-defining special authority "providers" and special authority transfer rules.
- **Safe Recovery from Emergency** - AOD enables recovering from different types of emergency situations with minimum risk of human error and maximum auditability.
- **Full Monitoring Capabilities** - AOD logs and monitors all relevant activities, enabling managers to receive regular audit reports and real-time e-mail alerts when employees request higher authority.
